What is an 'abandoned animal'?

- An abandoned animal is a pet that has no one to care for it, such as stray cats and stray dogs.
- They may be hungry, cold, or sick, and need our help.



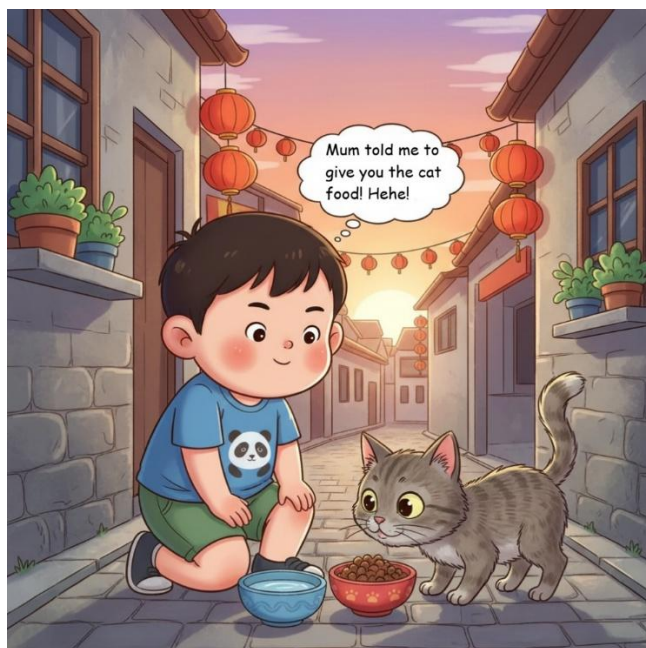
What can we do?

1. Do not abandon pets: Owning a pet is a lifelong responsibility.
2. Help stray animals: You can inform an adult or contact an animal protection organisation.
3. Do not frighten animals: Do not chase, hit, or bully small animals.



Animals also need love

- Animals, like us, can feel pain, happiness, and fear.
- We can:
 - Provide them with clean water and food (if an adult agrees).
 - Not disturb animals that are resting or eating.



What should I do if I see an animal that is injured or being bullied?

- Immediately inform a teacher, parent, or call the police (999).
- Remember: Do not approach the animal by yourself, safety first!
